

## STEP 6

### **"WERE ENTIRELY READY TO HAVE GOD REMOVE ALL THESE DEFECTS OF CHARACTER."**

We have emphasized willingness as being indispensable.

- a) Are we now ready to let God remove from us all the things, which we have admitted are objectionable? YES \_\_\_ NO \_\_\_

## STEP 7

### **"HUMBLY ASKED HIM TO REMOVE OUR SHORTCOMINGS"**

When ready, we say something like this:

"My Creator, I am now willing that you should have all of me, good and bad. I pray that you now remove from me every single defect of character, which stands in the way of my usefulness to you and my fellows. Grant me strength, as I go out from here, to do your bidding. Amen."

We have then completed Step Seven.
